She is the proud daughter of Bobby and Shirley Gadsden who taught her the power of love, God and family.

Verdel received her bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Massachusetts at Boston. However, she soon discovered that her passion was educating children. As a result, she received her master's degree in secondary education from Hofstra University, as well as her master's degree in educational leadership from Long Island University.

Verdel's talk show, "Conversations with Verdel Jones," is featured on several media platforms. Being a teacher at heart, her show is focused on sharing conversations that inform and enlighten – in the hopes that individuals learn something they may not have known. Providing relevant information to her viewers is what inspires her. Verdel is also the co-host of a groundbreaking intergenerational talk show, "Let's Kick It With The Joneses," which also co-stars her husband, Jeremiah and their grown-ish children Marcus and Miya. The premise of this show is to highlight a positive Black family who not only loves each other, but likes each other and can talk about topics that resonate with other families.

She is also the author of the must-have book, "The Parent Agent: How to Represent Your Child and Get Them Into the College of Their Choice." Her extensive knowledge of the college exploration and selection process; current educational issues; and the social and emotional challenges students experience, make her an expert in her field.

As the founder of DeliTeach Enterprises, LLC, she has been able to provide various services including speaking and hosting events dedicated to supporting her community. In 2019, Verdel founded the not-for-profit, Share Inform Enlighten Inc.



The mission of Share Inform Enlighten Inc. is to empower families with information and resources through educational programs to improve their quality of life. This mission is our driving force to see that everyone wins! Our focus is to provide information that will allow people, especially our youth, to grow and achieve their career and personal goals.

In June of 2018, we hosted our first Write, Rhyme and Recite Collective: Celebrating Young Poets & Highlighting Authors through DeliTeach Enterprises, LLC. Wanting to give authors a platform to share their stories, we created this program to also support literacy. In addition, we wanted to give graduating Long Island students scholarships via a poetry slam scholarship. In 2019, we hosted our second annual event. Starting in 2023, we began offering scholarships through our not-for-profit Share Inform Enlighten and have since awarded \$11,700.00 in scholarships. We are excited that our Write, Rhyme, & Recite Collective Honors - Celebrating Young Poets & Highlighting Community Champions event is back. We are not only awarding high school students scholarships, but we are celebrating individuals that positively impact our community.
